#### **AFTERSCHOOL**

The Afterschool Program is structured into two sessions, 2:30-3:30PM and 3:35-4:45PM following the 2:15-2:30PM Afterschool Transition/Break in the Cafeteria. Students may stay after for the first session or both.

- A Completed Afterschool Registration Form (Student FCPS Google Account) is required prior to participation. Students may <u>not</u> return for participation, Late Bus transportation, or pick-up after leaving campus. Students should not be on their phones during Afterschool without Staff permission – if they need to communicate with parents/care-givers they should let an adult know.
- 2. **Students** are required to complete the **Afterschool Attendance** Form each afternoon they stay after.
